

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The awards are only applicable in respect of a child who is registered at The Barn Nursery.
2. The awards will run until October 2009 and any registrations made prior to that date will qualify for the award as long as the start date is prior to October 2009, even if the qualifying date goes beyond October 2009. The management reserves the right to withdraw these awards at any time.
3. The “qualifying date” will be 12 weeks from the child’s “start date” as recorded on the official Registration form. The award only becomes valid and payable after that qualifying date. The referrer will be contacted after that time to ask if the award is to be made in cash, childcare vouchers or Boogle’s Barn vouchers. If you have not heard from us within 14 days of the qualifying date then please contact us to make your claim.
4. If the child leaves for whatever reason before the qualifying date then the award is not valid. This reason may be that the nursery or the parents have given notice to the child. The leaving date is defined as the date that the last payment is made for the child i.e. the last day of any notice period that has been given.
5. The award is applicable per child. Any number of awards can be claimed by the referrer whilst the awards are running.
6. A referrer cannot claim for their own children.
7. A referral is only valid if the referral is made prior to the child or their parents being registered at The Barn Nursery and if they have not already made contact to request information or an appointment to view. If the referrer knows that the parents will make contact prior to their form being returned then this needs to be notified to us either prior to, or during, that first contact. The burden of proof in case of any dispute due to the absence of a Referral Form prior to initial contact will be on the part of the referrer.
8. Only one referrer per child will be accepted. If more than one referrer makes a referral for the same child then the first properly completed Referral Form received will qualify. If it is not possible to determine who was first, the parents of the registered child will be asked to choose which referrer will receive the award.
9. The “attended sessions” in respect of the child are defined as the number of sessions per week that a child is registered for up to the qualifying date. This excludes any ad-hoc extra sessions. If the number of registered sessions per week increase or decrease over the first 12 weeks then the number of “attended sessions” will be the average registered sessions paid for over those 12 weeks.
10. The award that can be claimed per attended session is one of the following:
 - £10 in cash
 - £15 of childcare vouchers at The Barn nursery (to be used for clothing, extra curriculum activities or to pay towards your childcare)
 - £20 of Boogle’s Barn vouchers (includes admission, go-karts, parties and food but excludes merchandise purchases)
11. A registered session is a morning or afternoon and includes NEG funded sessions. The maximum number of sessions per child is therefore 10. For example, if a single pre-school age child is referred by you and takes up their 5 free NEG funded childcare sessions per week then you will receive either £50 in cash or £75 in childcare vouchers or £100 in Boogle’s Barn vouchers. If the child is full time then this would be £100 in cash, £150 in childcare vouchers or £200 in Boogle’s Barn vouchers.
12. The award is applicable only once per child. If a child leaves the nursery and then subsequently re-registers then that child will not qualify for the award when they re-register if an award has already been paid.
13. An information pack is available free of charge, which includes nursery leaflets and NEG funding leaflets. There is also further information such as Employer Voucher schemes.
